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About Us

The Coalition was founded in 2011 as a response to a widely reported incident involving a cross burning in Arroyo Grande. Steve Adams, then City Manager of Arroyo Grande, assembled a cadre of influential citizens to discuss what the community's response should be. While many others felt it unnecessary, with the support of the City government plus the NAACP Santa Maria Valley chapter and the Anti-Defamation League, the Five Cities Diversity Coalition was born.

In 2019, Five Cities expanded its reach to serve the etire county of San Luis Obispo County, changing it's name to Diversity Coalition San Luis Obispo County.
